Board of Investment, with the support of His Excellency (Masrour Barzani), Prime Minister of Kurdistan Regional Government, and the recommendations and instructions issued by the Council of Ministers to implement the reform program, began an important and contemporary qualitative leap to prepare work for the private sector and expand investment, today the investor in the Kurdistan Region witnesses the existence of equal and fair opportunities continuously to participate in expanding the region's economy and diversification of income sources so that local and foreign investors can participate effectively in reviving the various investment sectors (agriculture, industry, tourism, infrastructure, electricity and energy, housing, etc).

Since the announcement of the program of the ninth cabinet of the Kurdistan Regional Government with regard to reform, the Board of Investment has started making qualitative changes in the services and organizational structure of the Board, directing investors and creating appropriate and fair opportunities for them and the private sector by providing facilities and showing cooperation with investors by organizing and announcing the Kurdistan Investment Map as well as preparing and the application of the One Window Shop system for the purpose of granting investment licenses, reducing red tape, facilitating the allocation of lands and providing them with infrastructure services (water, sewage, electricity and roads). About the Kurdistan region

The Kurdistan Region of Iraq is a federal region. The region has wide legislative and administrative powers. It is headed by the Region's President and has a Parliament to legislate laws, Council of Ministers and a number of Ministries and Boards linked to the Council of Ministers.

The Kurdistan region is characterized by being largely mountainous and there are many rivers that pass through the region, where the Great Zab River, the Little Zab River and the Tigris River flow into Iraqi Kurdistan from Turkey and there are many other little rivers also pass through the region. Kurdistan is distinguished by its lands lush, abundant water, and stunning nature. Due to the mountainous nature and the difference in temperatures with other areas of Iraq and its water wealth made it an attractive agricultural

and tourist land. Thousands of tourists come from the hot Cities in Iraq, to the Kurdistan Region in the summer, as well as in the winter season to visit the mountainous regions views due to the beautiful and charming landscapes of the snow that falls in abundance.

In addition to all the resources, Kurdistan enjoys an abundance of wealth metallic and non-metallic minerals, as many of them were not Extracted so far for use in the mining sector and mineral industries, which is one of the important factors for attracting Investment in the mining sector in the region.



Administrative divisions:

The Kurdistan Region is administratively divided into four governorates (Erbil, Sulaymaniyah, Dohuk and Halabja), Erbil is the capital and each province is linked to a group of administrative departments such as the Garmian administration and the Raparin administration, districts, and villages.

Population:

According to statistics from the Statistics Board- KRG for 2020, the population in Kurdistan has reached 6,171,083; the population growth rate has reached 2.2. Some IDP (Iraq displaced people) 734,713 people are living in the region, as well as 257,941 refugees from neighboring countries who have gone to live safely in the region.

Universities:

There are sixteen public universities in the region and nineteen private universities from which thousands of students graduate that are qualified to work in the various fields and different private sector.

International airports:

In Kurdistan, there are two international airports in Erbil and Sulaymaniyah governorates, Erbil international airport is (6 km) away and Sulaymaniyah International Airport is about (11 km) away from the city center. In 2018, there were 1843,372 passengers and 21,445 flights to and from the two airports.

Number of hotels:

According to the statistics from the Statistics Board- KRG which was prepared in 2016, the total number of hotels in the region (370) hotels, in Erbil (185), Sulaymaniyah (112) and in Dohuk (73).

Hospitals:

According to the statistics from statistics board-KRG for 2019, the number of the hospitals is (128) registered in the region, (48) hospitals in Erbil, (55) in Sulaymaniyah, (22) in Duhok and in Halabj.

Government Outlines Agenda of Ninth Cabinet of Kurdistan Regional Government

At Economy and Finance Level

- **First:** we will work to diversify Kurdistan's economy, reducing our reliance on oil and gas. We will develop the agricultural, industrial, and tourism sectors to attract foreign investment.
- **Second:** the agricultural sector will be one of our main priorities, as we will introduce new methods, advanced machinery, and expand knowledge of scientific methods in order to improve quality across the sector. Furthermore, we will work to exploit our water resources, building dams and sources of sustainable energy. This will help preserve our water for agriculture, prevent desertification and increase green spaces.
- **Third:** we will work to restructure the banking system in the Kurdistan region, and ensure that the system serves both individuals and the public. We will encourage the use of bank accounts and electronic cards both to exchange currencies and reduce cash transactions.
- **Fourth:** we will encourage investment in all fields, by providing fair opportunities for both national and international investors; to achieve this; we will edit and modify the KRG's investment laws.

At the Services Level:

- **First:** we will work to enhance the public health sector, and to deliver a better-quality health service to the people. In addition, we will work to enact a health insurance system across the Kurdistan region.
- **Second:** we will work to find a fundamental solution to the issue of electricity supply: increasing production rates, decreasing electrical misuse or waste, and systematically distributing power in a technologically advanced manner.
- **Third:** we will work to increase educational teaching standards in the public sector. We will aim to attract local and international investors into the sector, helping to fund the building of new schools where they are needed.
- **Fourth:** we will work improve and rationalise the use of groundwater in order to raise the quality of public drinking water, while reducing the depletion rates of underground water sources.
- **Fifth:** we will work to improve road transportation links in the Kurdistan region, and enhance the traffic system. We will aim to attract foreign investors to this sector, reduce traffic accident casualties and introduce international traffic management best practices.
- **Sixth:** we will work to provide job opportunities in the private sector, and broaden investment in sectors including industry, agriculture, and tourism. We will reform labor laws to prioritise the provision of job opportunities for local workers instead of foreigners.
- **Seventh:** we will prioritise serving the families of Anfal, Peshmerga martyrs and those who were wounded in genocidal campaigns.
- **Eighth:** we will take measures to provide a comfortable and decent life for people with special needs.
- **Ninth:** Kurdistan's natural environment is a great treasure. We will work to preserve the environment and raise cultural awareness about its importance. Furthermore, we will work to establish an advanced recycling system to reduce the risks of waste contamination.
- **Tenth:** we will take measures to renovate villages, sub-districts, and districts, including measures to provide essential services, encouraging villagers to stay and work their land.
- **Eleventh:** we will encourage and foster the expansion of the work of civil communal organizations, helping to support events, sports, arts, and cultural activities in the Kurdistan region.
- **Twelfth:** we will enhance higher education and scientific research by developing this sector. We will enhance the capacity of the universities and institutes of the Kurdistan region in terms of quality, and help expand scientific research and study opportunities.
- **Thirteenth:** we will introduce digitisation of government systems (E-Government); transforming citizens' interaction with government procedures and services. This will cut bureaucracy, reduce wastage of public wealth and time, and increase the overall quality of services.
- **Fourteenth:** One of our priorities is to work on providing services to citizens electronically (e-government), whether in the field of government institutions or at the level of providing services to citizens electronically. We prevent red tape through this, reduce waste of money and time, and raise the level of performance of institutions as well.
- **Fifteenth:** Young people are a great national capital, and they are the future of the country. From this point of view and within the framework of the program of all ministries, we work to operate and direct their capabilities to build a healthy and advanced society in a way that guarantees the region a prosperous future.
- **Sixteenth:** Archaeological sites are an integral part of our heritage and history, and preserving them is a national duty and will be one of our priorities. We urge the adoption of strengthening effective mechanisms to make it a tourist destination in accordance with the established standards.

Investment Law no. 4 of 2006

Incentives

- Allocation of lands for investment projects. Provision of land plots for subsidized lease.
- Provision of public infrastructure for investment projects (e.g. water, electricity, sewage, public roads).
- The project is exempt from all taxes and non-customs fees for a period of ten years, starting from the date on which the project began providing services or the date of actual production.
- Exemption from customs duties for imported raw materials (5 years).
- Machinery, apparatus, equipment, machinery and machinery shall be exempt Imported for the project from taxes, fees and condition obtaining an import license.
- Spare parts imported for the project are exempt from taxes Fees, provided that their value does not exceed (15%) The value of machinery and equipment.
- Machinery, tools, equipment shall be exempted Necessary for expanding, developing or updating the project from Taxes and Fees.
- The Supreme Investment Council, based on suggestion of Investment Board to own the lands that are allocated for strategic projects at an incentive price, or without allowance.

Why investment law issued?!!

- Economic development of the Kurdistan Region in all sectors, except for oil and gas. Create a suitable environment for work in the Kurdistan Region.
- Create conducive business climate that promotes investment in the Kurdistan Region.
- Remove legal obstacles facing the private sector.

Legal guarantees for domestic and foreign investment

- The foreign investor is allowed to transfer abroad the profits and interest of his capital in accordance with the provisions of this law. Full repatriation of profits generated by the project and wages earned by foreign employees.
- The investor may transfer his investment wholly or in part to another foreign investor or to a national investor. The foreign investor has the right to invest in Kurdistan alone or jointly with a local investor.

Additional Exemption

The Board may grant additional facilities and incentives to:

- For approved investment projects that are being held in less developed areas in the region.
- For joint projects between the national and foreign investors.
- For projects of hotels, hospitals, tourist cities, universities and schools for modernization purposes every 3 years.

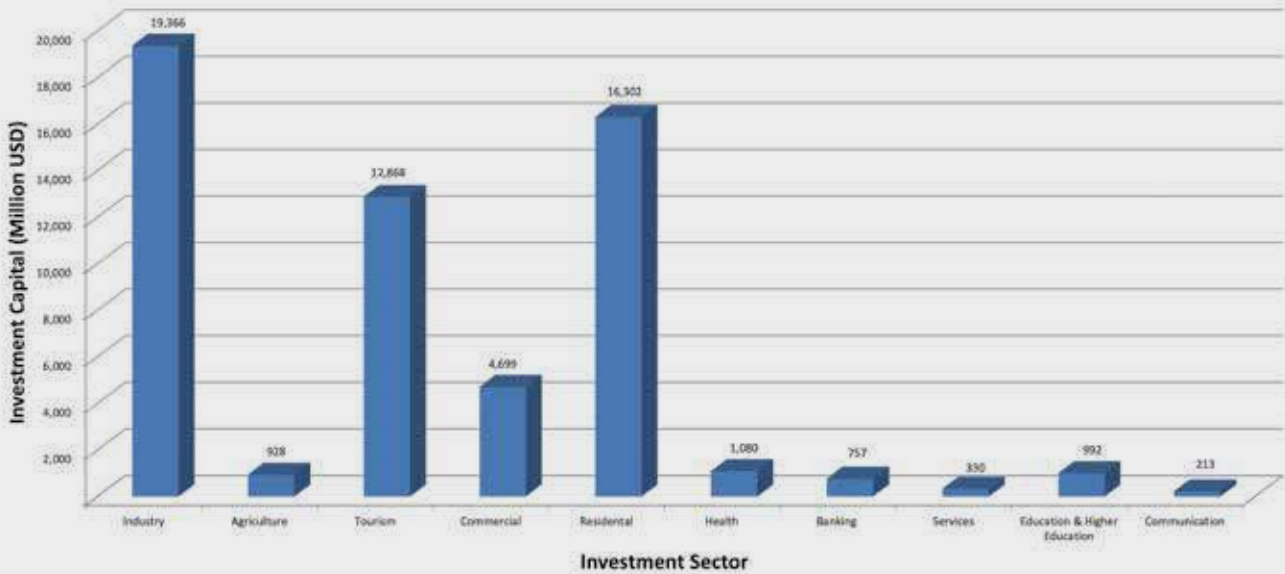
Overview

Identifications and Clarifications

Board of Investment: An independent body and it is one of the formations of the Council of Ministers of the Kurdistan Regional Government established by law Investment No. 4 of 2006, chaired by the Chairman of the Board.

Branches of the Board of Investment: The General Directorates of Investment in the governorates (Erbil, Sulaymaniyah and Dohuk) and the investment directorates in the Garmian administration and Rapren management.

The Supreme Council for Investment: The Supreme Council for Investment is composed from the Prime Minister as Chairman, Deputy Prime Minister as Deputy and ministerial membership (Finance and Economy, Commerce and Industry, Municipalities, Planning, Agriculture) and the Chairman of the Board of Investment.

Investor: Natural or artificial person, whether a local or a foreigner, who invests his funds in the Region in accordance with the provisions of this Law no. 4 of 2006.

Invested Funds: Value of the funds invested in the Project and estimated in national or foreign currency.

Foreign Capital: Amount of investments, whether in cash, in kind or in rights and interests, which have a cash value in the Region. Foreign capital: is what the investor invests in cash or in kind or rights that have a financial value in the region.

Investment Project: Any economic activity or investment project set up by a natural or artificial person on an allocated plot of land, and with a national or foreign capital to which the provisions of this Law and relevant regulations and directives apply.

Necessary data: project cost, production or service capacity, or Capacity according to the investment sector attached to the initial design for components

of a project, the space required to set up the project, opportunities. The resulting work for the project, economic feasibility study, technology used, project completion period, criteria used and how information or other data related to the project.

Investment license: It is the document granted by the Board of Investment to the investor (the project owner) who receives all the rights responsibilities of all duties of the investment in the region.

Project completion time: It is the time period that the investor to complete the investment project and start production or service (according to investment sector).

Standards: They are the applicable local or international standards or standards Issued by certified and accredited international bodies.

Project components: includes all components in the maps Certification and investment license.

Project Area: The project area is determined according to the initial design.

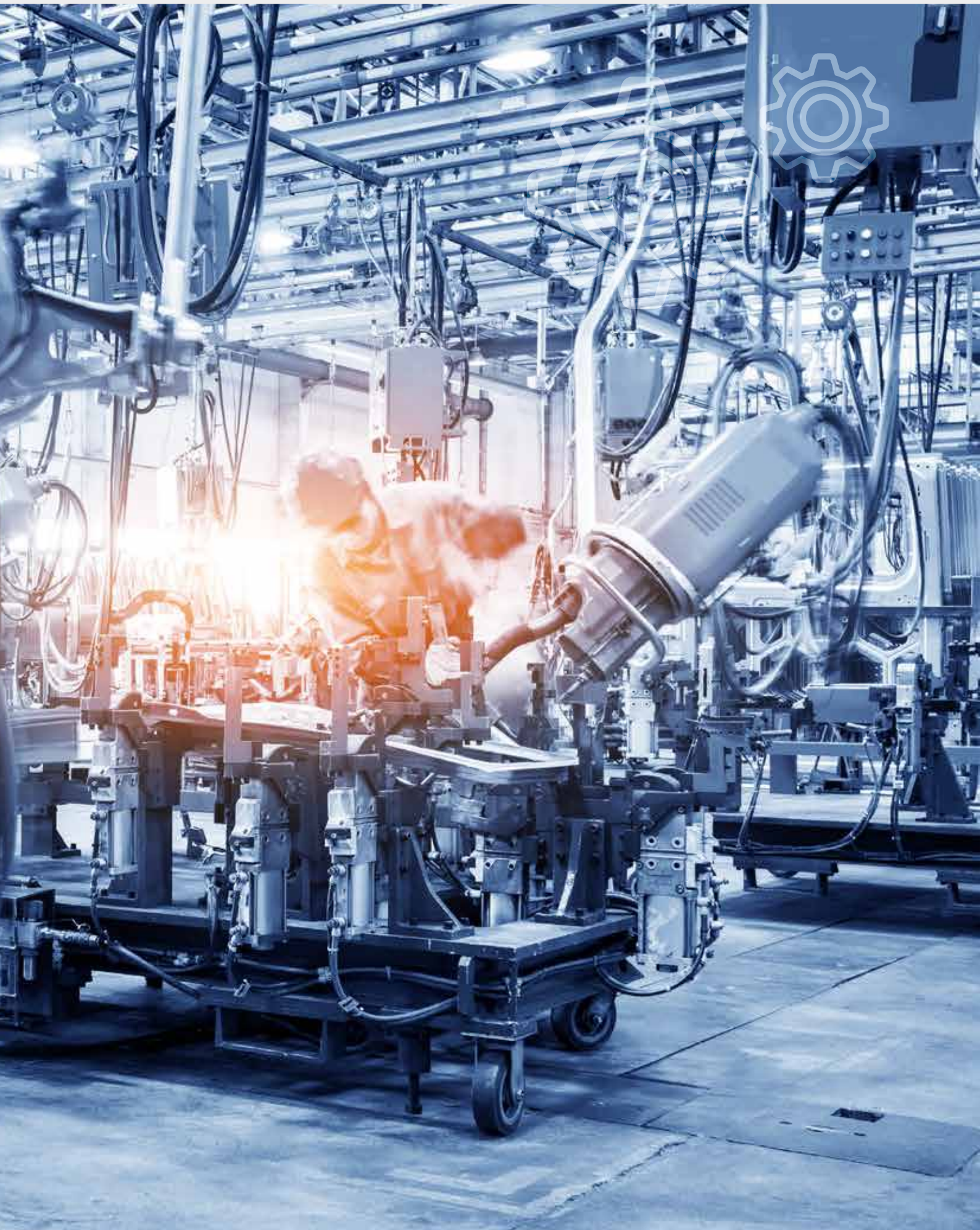
Economic feasibility study: the technical and economic study that is conducted prepared by a specialized office licensed by the Syndicate of Economists in the region and depends on the real market data in the region.



Investment in Industrial Sector

Ingredients:

- Kurdistan and other parts of Iraq are described as a large market for the marketing of industrial products, as most of the goods currently in place are imported.
- Mineral resources in the region have not yet been exploited in the mineral industries where the region enjoys an abundance of un mined & nonmetallic minerals that can be used in the mining sector, from this point of view the draft law of mineral investment in Kurdistan Region has been prepared.
- Kurdistan has a very favorable climate for working in the all kinds of industrial sector. The climate of the region is moderate; the hot and cold seasons do not pose any obstacle to the continuity of work in the industrial sector.
- The abundance of agricultural fruits and vegetables, which is a major source of raw materials used in agricultural industries, is also a key factor for achieving food security.
- Kurdistan is known as a tourist and agricultural region, which has a positive impact on the success and development of its industrial sector.
- The pharmaceutical and medical industries in the region have been established since the issuance of investment law No. 4 of 2006 based on international standards, including Good Pharmaceutical Manufacturing Practices (cGMP), which at this stage need to be expanded and developed.
- Abundant workforce with high scientific, professional, skills and low-cost experience
- Kurdistan is located in the Middle East region where its borders are close to the Europe countries to Export modern technologies and exchange experts .
- The region is located near the international ports of Iraq - Basra, Jordan - Aqaba, Turkey - Mersin.
- The presence of commercial stores (Cargo) at Erbil and Sulaymaniyah international airports that facilitate the transport of raw materials, transport goods and products which strength trade to and from the region.
- The establishment of cities and industrial zones and the existence of studies Prepared for this purpose in order to create an investment environment in the industrial sector in the region.



Investment in the establishment of cities and industrial zones



Ingredients:

- The establishment of cities and industrial zones is an urgent and necessary need in the region to assemble industrial projects in an appropriate environment and equipped with services such as commercial centers, exhibitions, quality control centers, training institutes, health centers, and residences of foreign workers, civil defense centers, sports stadiums, mosques and any other services.
- The large number of industrial varieties needs to establish specialized zone such as the food industry area, the pharmaceutical industry area, medical supplies area, petrochemical industry area, light industry area, etc. A group of these designated areas are assembled in one large industrial city or industrial zone provided with infrastructure services (water, sewage, electricity, roads, service centers, vocational educational centers, accommodation for foreigners, etc.).
- Scientific skilled proficient work force from graduates of universities and institutes can be used to manage and operate cities and industrial areas at a cheap cost.

Actual procedures and facilities:

- Inviting investors directly by the Board of Investment for the purpose of applying for the establishment of cities and industrial zones, and the Board studies offers, choose the best ones and grant investment license to the investor as a developer provide the industrial cities and zones are a distinctive environment and attractive for local and foreign investment, housing and work worldwide, through the development and management of industrial cities and zones to be integrated cities, with sustainable growth and economic, legal, social environment attractive and competitive leading to strengthen the economic infrastructure and national income.
- Providing all facilities to grant customs exemptions for the purpose of importing raw materials.
- The implementation mechanism is under the Investment Contract, PPP or BOT.
- The Board of Investment coordinates with the related departments for the purpose of speeding up the acquisition of fundamentalist approvals.
- Remove all obstacles facing city and industrial projects.
- Providing the developer with all the information concerning industrial projects that are held in cities and industrial zones that lead to an increase in the profit rate for him.
- Work to preserve and protect all the rights of developers and investors under the laws and regulations in force in the region.
- Delivery of infrastructure services (water, sewage, electricity, roads) to the industrial area or city under investment law No. 4 of 2006.

Investment in the petrochemical industry

Ingredients:

- Availability of raw materials represented by natural gas, which is a national treasure in the Kurdistan region.
- Availability of black oil in oil refineries located in the region.
- The use of materials produced from the oil and gas industry in the petrochemical industries.
- The presence of a large market in the region and the rest of Iraq for the purpose of marketing petrochemical products and the possibility of exporting surplus.
- Production of petrochemical materials such as urea, ammonia gas, ethylene and propylene from natural gas, the use of urea as agricultural fertilizer, the production of various pigments and engine lubricants from black oil and their use in mechanical and construction industries and the use of industrial threads and nylon in textile industries.

Actual procedures and facilities:

- All the facilities are provided by the environment for the purpose of obtaining customs exemptions and facilitating the importation of materials for the project.
- Take the necessary measures to place customs duties on imported products similar to local petrochemical products to protect of the local product.
- The Board of Investment coordinates with the Ministry of Natural Resources and related authorities to obtain raw materials involved in production.



Investment opportunities in Petrochemical Industry

1. Petrochemical Plants (Ammonia & Urea & other Production), production capacity more than 1,000,000 ton/year.
2. Ethylene & Propylene Plant, production capacity more than 150,000 ton/year.
3. Nylon & Polyester Fabrics Production Plant, production capacity more than 200,000 ton/year.
4. PVC Production Plant from Raw Materials, production capacity more than 200,000 ton/year.
5. Plant producing pigments of different colors, waxes (wax), Glue, Silicon and other black oil with a production capacity of more than 50,000 tons/year.
6. Plant for the production of engine lubricants from black oil with a production capacity of more than 1,000,000 liters/year.



Investment in the pharmaceutical and medical industries

Ingredients:

- The presence of the Kurdistan Medical Control Agency (KMCA)/ Ministry of Health in the Kurdistan Regional Government. This agency specialized of Import and Manufacturing of Medicines, Equipment and Medical Supplies, and granting license to import and manufacture medicines, equipment and medical supplies, and this agency is responsible for the tests of quality control of pharmaceutical and medical products in the region, where it adopts the standards of good pharmaceutical manufacturing (cGMP) and ISO No. 13485 for the establishment of related projects.
- The pharmaceutical industry has been in the region Since more than 12 years, but the industry needs to diversify and expand to suit the requirements for achieving medical and medicine security in the region.
- Due to the large market in the region and other areas of Iraq, it has become necessary to establish other investment projects in this industrial category to meet the needs of the region and the rest of Iraq, which is a key factor for increase investment in the pharmaceutical and medical supplies industries.

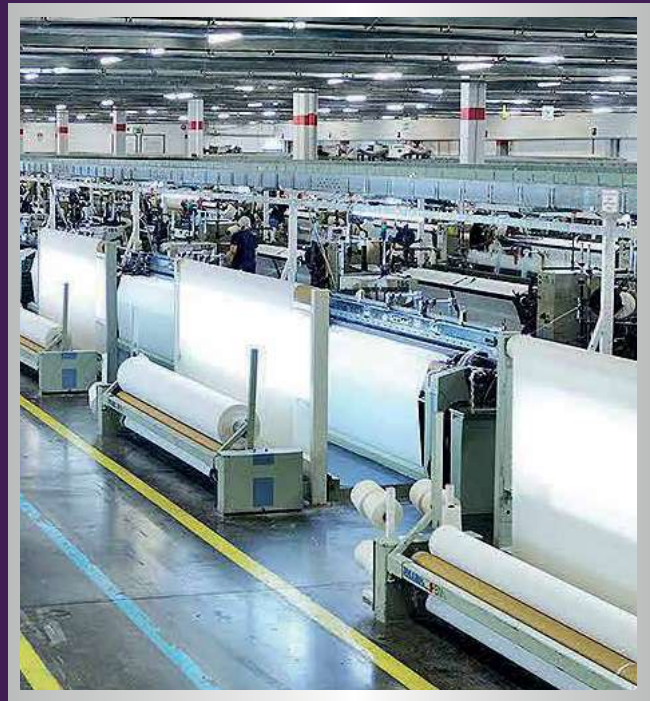
Investment in textile industries

Bekodian lake is located in the Erbil Governorate / Choman District, in the Balkayti region, at the summit peak of Sakran Mountain, between the peaks of Berkhiland and Qarad. The height of this lake above sea level is 3150 M, which is the highest lake above sea level in the Kurdistan Region and Iraq.
